Band/Percussion

Course Description:

Band and Percussion is an academic elective that receives one credit per year and fulfills the state requirement for Fine Arts credit. Band members meet in two separate classes: percussionists and wind players. These classes function as learning laboratories in which students develop individual skills, rehearse the best literature in the wind and percussion genre, and learn about music theory and history.

In addition: all students must take private leassons from a qualified teacher of their instrument.
